


Fig. 1. AARI oceanographic stations in Davies Sea during the Russian Antarctic Expedition in January 2017 (red dots *SeaBird 911*+ soundings with sampling, blue dots *SeaCat* soundings).




Fig. 2. AARI *SeaCat* soundings in Bransfield Strait during the Russian Antarctic Expedition in April 2017.

In the period 15 – 31 January 2017 three CTD/O2 transects (112 stations) were made from r/v *Akademik Fedorov* in the Davies Sea. Oceanographic stations were performed by "Sea Bird 911+" probe with water sampling to determine the nutrients on the particular horizons. Two sections were made along the Shakleton Ice Shelf front (Fig. 1). Two sections (26 stations) were made in 9 – 11 April 2017 in the northern part of Bransfield Strait and on the continental slope of the South Shetland Islands in the southern Drake Passage (Fig. 2).
